2022 Registration Box Report

The Grand County Wilderness Group has been monitoring and maintaining registration boxes for trailheads leading to Wilderness Areas for the US Forest Service since the year 2000. There are now a total of 12 registration boxes that are maintained by the GCWG. A volunteer provides registration sheets, retrieves them and tabulates the numbers for that trail. These numbers are given to a Coordinator who puts them together and writes a report for the Forest Service. This report has been identified as being very important in Forest Service planning and funding.

This year another very short report. We did receive a report from Devils Thumb, including data from both 2021 & 2022.

Below is a tabular listing of all the data obtained for the total number of visitors at each trailhead registration box. In 2022 we are still seeing the results of wildfires(primarily the Troublesome fire) on our wilderness sites. Data was available from 10 of the 12 original registration boxes. The North Supply box was destroyed, and the Kinney Creek box was in a closed area (previous fire).

Also we have data for hikers on the Continental Divide Trail(CDT) which passes through several of our Grand County Wilderness areas. Bowen trailhead reported 392 CDT hikers, while Monarch Lake reported 50.
